1. Sustained gains in **reading scores** for elementary and middle school students **7.9%**



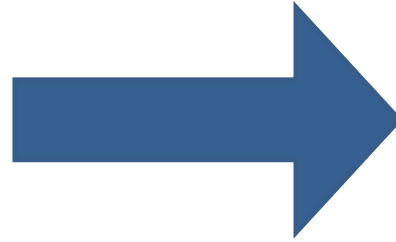
