



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

The Effect of School Construction on Test Scores, School Enrollment, and Home Prices

Christopher Neilson Yale University Seth Zimmerman Yale University



- 1. Sustained gains in **reading scores** for elementary and middle school students **7.9%**
- 2. Raise neighborhood **home prices** by **4.7%**
- **3. Enrollment** of neighborhood residents in public schools increased by **16.2%**
